Humzell Williams Nash was born on April 12, 1932 in Washington DC. The second child of Albert and Lucille Williams preceded her in death.

Humzell attended DC public schools and graduated from Cardozo High School in 1950. Humzell worked at the U.S. Government Printing Office in Washington, D.C. as an Accountant Supervisor. She retired with 38 years of service.

At an early age Humzell met and married Jesse Nash deceased, and out of that union was born four children, Carl Nash and Gregory Nash preceded her in death, Carolyn Olidge and Darryl Nash. Humzell and Jesse were happily married for over 40 years.

Humzell declared Jesus Christ as her Savior at a very young age. She joined Saint Paul Christian Community Church in Washington D.C. where she was an active member for over 40 years under the late Reverend Walter C. Clever and Reverend Earl S. Lockett.

In later years Humzell became an active member of New Life Family Fellowship Christian Church. She sang on the Praise Team and was active in Sunday School. She also attended The National Association Council of Community Churches of America and Elsewhere (NACCCAE) for 60 + years.

Humzell was one of the chosen Mother's of the National Counsel.

Humzell achieved many accomplishments in her many years as a gospel soloist. One of which she was very thankful for, the recording of her first CD entitled "God Is Still Blessing Me", which is timeless. She also had an opportunity to travel and record with various well known choirs on the East Coast.

Humzell will always be remembered for her many sayings such as: "God Will Always Take Care of Me." "Give God All the Glory.", "Jesus Will Never Forsake Me.", "Jesus Hold My Hand.", "I Surrender All.", "Help Me Lord.", "When He Calls Me I Will Answer." "Walk With Me Lord", and "I Love The Lord."

She'll also be remembered by family for some rather funny sayings such as: "You got that right", answering the phone with "Hello sweetie", "I'm gonna sock you", "Okay babe", "Oh WoW", "You done lost your mind", "You just as crazy as you can be" and if she accidentally drops her pills "Aww man!"
